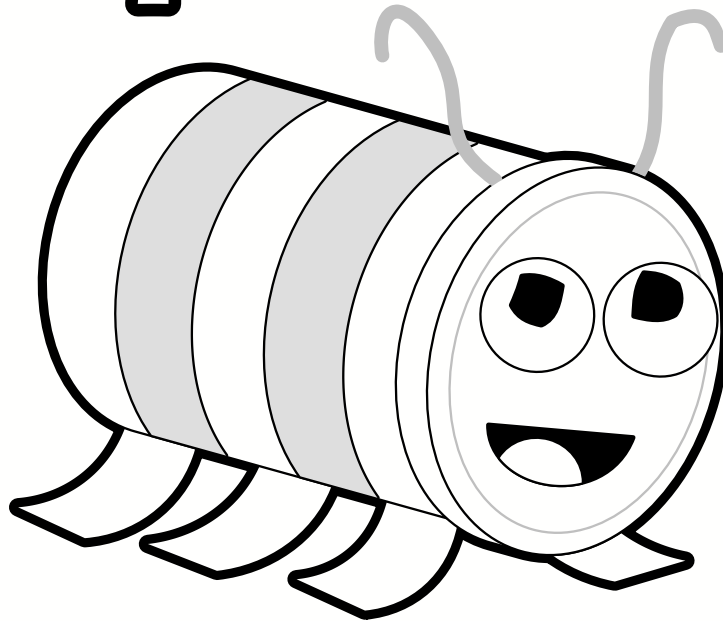
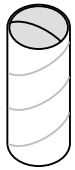


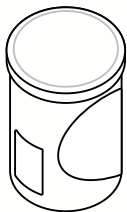
Make a Caterpillar Keepsake Box



What do you need?



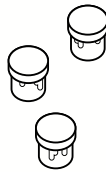
Paper tube



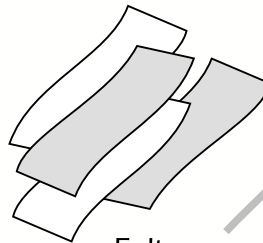
Round container



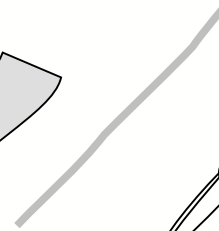
White glue



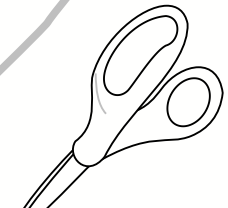
Poster paints



Felt



Pipe cleaner



Scissors

For the body: Cut 6 or 7 strips of felt to fit around the container, depending on how wide you make them. You can use a different color for each strip.

Coat the container with glue and wrap it with the felt strips from top to bottom.

For the legs: Cut 3 1-inch rings from the paper tube. Cut each ring in half and paint them with the poster paint. When they are dry, glue 3 halves on each side of the caterpillar.

For the antennae: Poke 2 holes at the top of the caterpillar's head and pass the pipe cleaner through them. Curl the ends.

For the face: Cut out eyes and a mouth from felt and glue them on the lid of the container. You can also use two cotton balls for eyes.

Let the glue dry and you will have your caterpillar. You can take the lid (the face) off to keep things in it!
