Your role as a chaperone:

We are a free self-guided museum - that means YOU are the tour guide. It is your job to read the signage to your students (aloud if they are too young to read). We recommend asking them questions about the creatures as you observe them together.

As a tour guide, you must stay with your students. We recommend staying within 3-5 feet at all times. Why so close? To remind students not to tap on glass. This stresses our bugs and reptiles immensely - which in turn shortens their life span. This is sad and expensive. Prepare your group for their visit by talking about respect and care for our creature friends.

Most importantly - have fun! We hope you all enjoy your visit and learn something new.



DO'S:

- 🚫 Stay with your students
- 🚫 Read the placards
- 🚫 Ask students questions
- 🚫 Hypothesize
- 🚫 Help with scavenger hunts
- 🚫 Take photos
- 🚫 Draw pictures
- 🚫 Observe and compare
- 🚫 Talk and laugh and have a good time



DONT'S:

- 🚫 Let children run
- 🚫 Tap on glass
- 🚫 Put things in the animal or insect tanks
- 🚫 Touch or handle displays unless signage says otherwise
- 🚫 Smash/ touch "painted lady" Butterfly feet
- 🚫 Sit on the bench and ignore your students
