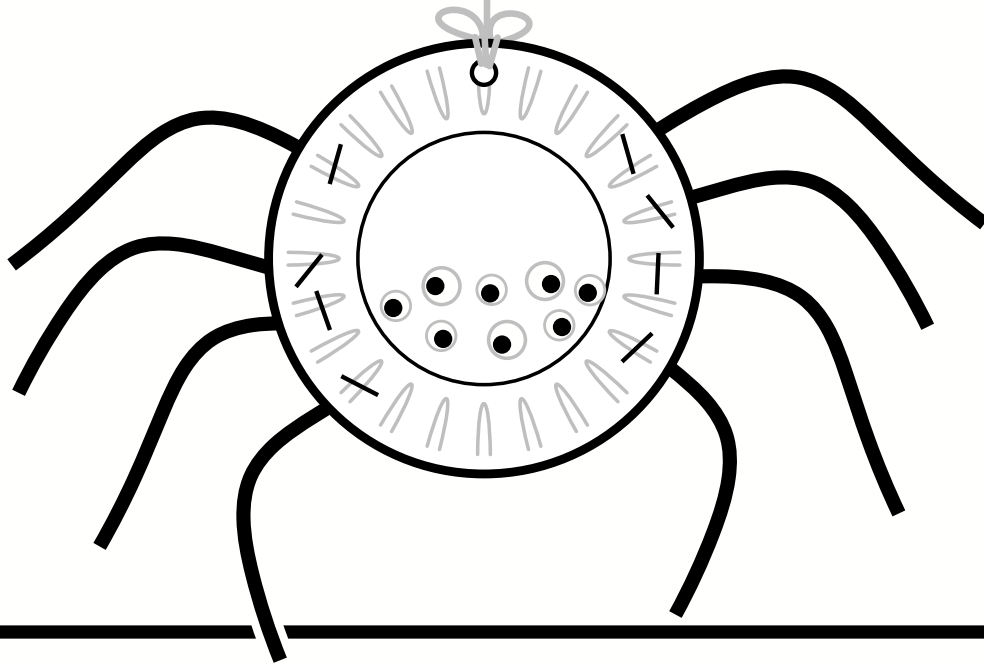
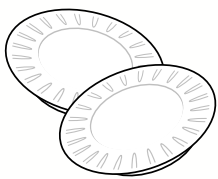


Make a Paper Plate Spider



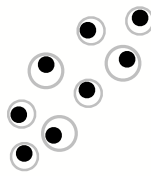
What do you need?



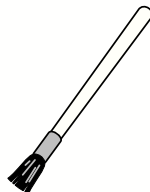
2 Paper plates



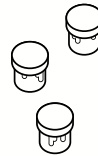
White glue



Googly eyes



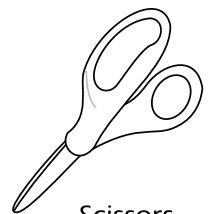
Paint Brush



Acrylic paint



4 Pipe cleaners



Scissors

Paint the underside of the two small paper plates and let them dry completely.

When the paint has finished drying, cut the four pipe cleaners in half to make eight spider legs.

Line up the paper plates with the paint facing out on both sides. Place a staple at the top to connect them together.

Insert the spider legs in between the plates (four on each side). Staple them down. Bend them in the middle.

Place more staples around the paper plates to close them shut.

Glue on eight googly eyes of different sizes on the top of your spider.

Punch a hole in the top of the paper plate spider and tie a white string through it so you can hang it up as if it's coming down its spider web!

Note: In case you can't get a stapler, use glue and tape instead!
